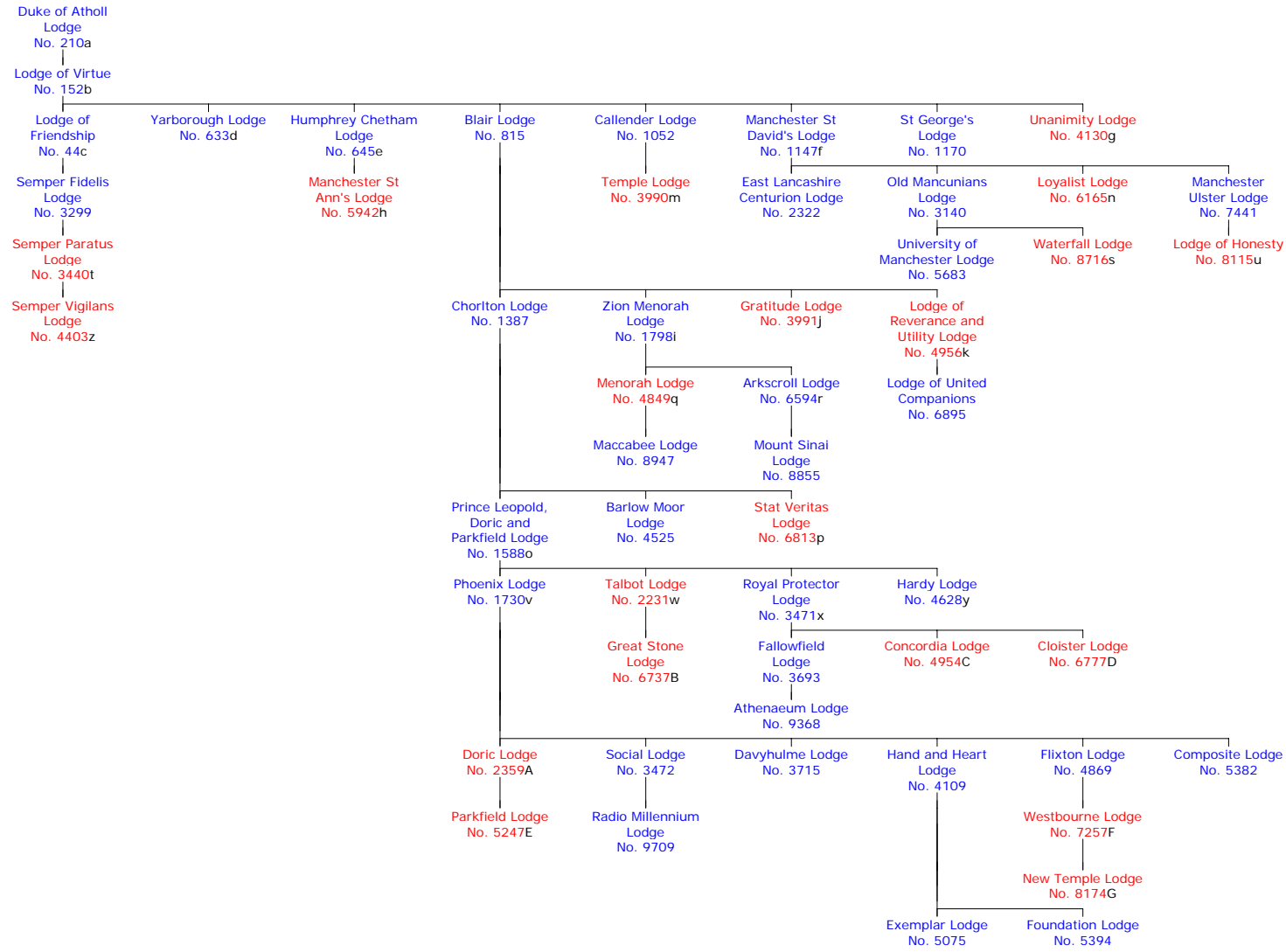

Notes:

- a) See Chart 210. Reference is included here to show full genealogy of Lodge No. 152 and dependants. Formerly on Atholl or Antient Grand Lodge Roll (289 Antients). It's petition was a revival of 39B Antients supported by 275 Antients and 278 Antients (now Caledonian Lodge No. 204 (E. Lancs.)), but this warrant again lapsed on 4th March 1795. Lodge No. 289 Antients was then formed on 21st March 1795 supported by Lodge No. 275 Antients and Lodge No. 283 Antients.
- b) Continued from Chart 210. Formerly on Atholl or Antient Grand Lodge Roll (201B Antients). It is not possible to determine the exact Mother Lodge of Lodge of Virtue No. 152 but it is most probable that the primary sponsoring Lodge was Lodge No. 289 Antients (now Duke of Atholl Lodge No. 210 (E. Lancs.)), which was supported by Lodge No. 275 Antients (now defunct), Lodge No. 296 Antients (now defunct) and Lodge No. 297 Antients (now Lodge of Commerce No. 215 (E. Lancs.)). Amalgamated with Unanimity Lodge No. 4130 (E. Lancs.) in December 2001.
- c) Formerly Lodge No. 39C Antients. Recommended by 201 Antients (now 152), 275 Antients (later 244 - 1832 number, now defunct), 278 Antients (now 204), 289 Antients (now 210), 296 Antients (later 260 - 1832 number, now defunct) and 297 Antients (now 215). Petition was signed by these 6 Lodges in numerical order. There is no indication which was the prime sponsor.
- d) In conjunction with Lodge of Affability No. 317 (E. Lancs.).
- e) In conjunction with Lodge of Friendship No. 44 (E. Lancs.).
- f) Amalgamated with Manchester Lodge No. 2554 (E. Lancs.) in March, 2007. At the same time, St David's Lodge No. 1147 changed name to Manchester St David's Lodge No. 1147.
- g) Erased in December, 2001. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Lodge of Virtue No. 152 (E. Lancs.).
- h) Erased in December, 2000. Unable to attract a sufficient flow of new members and has suffered very low attendance.
- i) Amalgamated with Menorah Lodge No. 4849 (E. Lancs.) in March, 2006 and name changed from Zion Lodge No. 1798 to Zion Menorah Lodge No. 1798.
- j) Erased in September, 2000. Unable to attract a sufficient flow of new members and has suffered very low attendance.
- k) Renamed from Lodge of Reverence No. 4956 to Lodge of Reverence and Utility Lodge No. 4956 in June 2001 following the amalgamation with Lodge of Utility No. 4766. Erased in December 2006. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- l) Erased in September 2008. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- m) Erased in June, 2001. Unable to attract a sufficient flow of new members and has suffered very low attendance.
- n) Amalgamated with Doric Lodge No. 2359 (W. Lancs.) and Parkfield Lodge No. 5247 (W. Lancs.) in September, 2004 and name revised from Prince Leopold Lodge to Prince Leopold, Doric and Parkfield Lodge.
- o) Erased in December, 2004. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Royal Protector Lodge No. 3471 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Concordia Lodge No. 4954 also amalgamated with Royal Protector Lodge No. 3471 (W. Lancs.) at the same time.
- p) Erased in March, 2006. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Zion Lodge No. 1798 (E. Lancs.).
- q) Lodge No. 6594 revised its name from Ark Lodge to Arkscroll Lodge when it amalgamated with Scroll Lodge No. 7395 in December 2007.
- r) Erased in September 2004. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- s) Erased in September 2005. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- t) Erased in December 2007. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- u) Amalgamated with Talbot Lodge No. 2231 (W. Lancs.), Great Stone Lodge No. 6737 (W. Lancs.) and Westbourne Lodge No. 7257 (W. Lancs.) in March, 2007. At the same time, Urmston Lodge No. 1730 changed name to Phoenix Lodge No. 1730.
- v) Erased in March, 2007. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Great Stone Lodge No. 6737 and Westbourne Lodge No. 7257 also amalgamated with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.) at the same time. Also, Urmston Lodge No. 1730 changed name to Phoenix Lodge No. 1730 at the time of the amalgamation.
- w) Amalgamated with Concordia Lodge No. 4954 (W. Lancs.) and Stat Veritas Lodge No. 6813 (W. Lancs.) in December, 2004.
- x) Not meeting.
- y) Erased in December, 2008. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Manchester Epworth Lodge No. 3921 (E. Lancs.). At the same time, Lodge No. 3921 revised its name from Manchester Epworth Lodge to Quadrivium Lodge.
- z) Erased in September, 2004. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Prince Leopold Lodge No. 1588 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Parkfield Lodge No. 5247 also amalgamated with Prince Leopold Lodge No. 1588 (W. Lancs.) at the same time.
- A) Erased in March, 2007. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Talbot Lodge No. 2231 and Westbourne Lodge No. 7257 also amalgamated with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.) at the same time. Also, Urmston Lodge No. 1730 changed name to Phoenix Lodge No. 1730 at the time of the amalgamation.
- B) Erased in December, 2004. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Royal Protector Lodge No. 3471 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Stat Veritas Lodge No. 6813 also amalgamated with Royal Protector Lodge No. 3471 (W. Lancs.) at the same time.
- C) Erased in December 2004. Over recent years, the Lodge had found itself no longer viable.
- D) Erased in September, 2004. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Prince Leopold Lodge No. 1588 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Doric Lodge No. 2359 also amalgamated with Prince Leopold Lodge No. 1588 (W. Lancs.) at the same time.
- E) Erased in March, 2007. Warrant returned in order that the Lodge could amalgamate with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.). Memo: Talbot Lodge No. 2231 and Great Stone Lodge No. 6737 also amalgamated with Urmston Lodge No. 1730 (W. Lancs.) at the same time. Also, Urmston Lodge No. 1730 changed name to Phoenix Lodge No. 1730 at the time of the amalgamation.
- F) Erased in December 2002. Experienced problems attracting a sufficient flow of new members and has suffered very low attendance.
